Order of Preference for Admission to the UG Programmes:

1. Order of Preference for Subjects other than Modern Indian Languages (MIL):

- (a) The student must have studied Domain Subject in Qualifying Examination (10+2) and appeared in Domain Subject test of CUET-UG-23 Examination.

Note: Admission in this case will be on the basis of the Composite Score of the Domain Subject + English + General Test of the CUET-UG-23.

- (b) Not Studied Domain Subject in Qualifying examination (10+2) but appeared in that Subject in CUET-UG-23.

Note: Admission in this case will be on the basis of the Composite Score of the Subject + English + General Test of the CUET-UG-23, subject to the condition that the candidate obtained minimum 30% in that subject in CUET-UG-23.

- (c) Composite Score of the **Language** and **General Test** of the CUET-UG-23.

2. Order of Preference for Modern Indian Languages (MIL):

- (a) **In case of languages** such as Hindi / Hindi Literature, English / English Literature/ Functional English, Dogri, Punjabi, Sanskrit, Urdu, Kashmiri, Arabic & Persian the admission shall be granted on the composite score of the **Domain Language + General Test** of the CUET-UG

- (b) Not studied language in qualifying examination (10+2) but appeared in that Language in CUET-UG-23.

Note: Admission in this case will be on the basis of the Composite Score of that Language + General Test of the CUET-UG-23, subject to the condition that the candidate obtained minimum 30% in that subject in CUET-UG-23.

- (c) On the basis of the Score of the **General Test** of the CUET-UG-23.

NOTE:

1. In case of the following the Admissions will be on the basis of English + General Test of CUET-UG-23:

- a.
- b. Business Management
- c. Management
- d. Marketing Management
- e. Music
- f. Library Science
- g. Philosophy
- h. Public Administration

2. In case, if the seats lie vacant, even after the exhaustion of all the above criteria, the past practice shall be followed for admission.
